

STARFLEET EXPLORER

Six years ago, the first clock co-created by L'Épée 1839 and MB&F, Starfleet Machine, emerged. Six years later, it gives way to its new, smaller, gleaming «sister» : Starfleet Explorer !

More compact but equally effective, Starfleet Explorer is now equipped with three little spaceships circling around the heart of the mechanism at a rate of one full rotation every five minutes, like they were exploring universe, giving at the same time the inspiration to Starfleet Explorer's name.

The three linear axes maintain a perfect stability of the clock, which can be laid straight or on the leftside. Hours and minutes are indicated on two discs and pointed via two different brightly-coloured hand : minutes stand on the swiveling dominant saucer and are showed just as they pass in the centre of the static vertical hand. In contrast to the minute mechanics, the second disc above, on which hours are inset, stays stationary ; the horizontal moves instead and signals the hour, making a full turn in 12 hours.

The movement is horizontally disposed as the escapment is vertically positioned and a dual-use key enables both movement winding and time setting. The delicate curves and impeccable finishings offer a refined and graceful design and can be easily included into your space.
