



L'EPÉE 1839 TIME FAST D8

Working with MB&F has rubbed off nicely on the clockmakers at L'Epee 1839. Striking out on their own, the Time Fast is as quirky and inspired as any of their collaborative efforts, following the curves and lines of a vintage racer straight out of the 1950s. Under the hood its engine lasts for a solid eight days, wound in the same way as a pull-back toy car. The time, displayed on the side, is set using the steering wheel in front of the driver, whose glass-domed helmet showcases the thrumming escapement. Limited to 100 pieces, it's part timekeeper, part motorsport homage, all awesome.

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
